Visitors of all ages come to Old Cahawba to explore its undisturbed natural setting. The park not only teaches visitors about Alabama's history, but it also teaches them about its abundant wildlife and diverse landscape.

Lying at confluence of the Alabama and Cahaba rivers, Old Cahawba is an integral part of the Alabama Scenic River Trail, the longest state recreational water trail in America.

With assistance from the Nature Conservancy, the Alabama Historical Commission opened a canoe launch in 2009.

The park has 6.5 miles of walking trails, and 6 miles of biking trails. The Bring Your Own Bike (BYOB) tour is a great way to explore the site.
