## Coffeeville Masonic Lodge listed to the Alabama Register

The Alabama Historical Commission recently listed the Coffeeville Masonic Lodge to the Alabama Register of Landmarks and Heritage. The Alabama Register is an official listing of buildings, sites, structures, objects, and districts. These properties, which may be of national, state, and local significance, are deemed worthy of preservation by the Alabama Historical Commission.

The lodge, first built before the Civil War, was rebuilt in the early twentieth century after it was destroyed by a storm. The two-story frame building is the center of many activities in Coffeeville, and is still an active lodge today.

The nomination was the effort of Henry Dunagan of Coffeeville.

Listing to the Alabama Register is an honorary designation and carries no restrictions or financial incentives.
